David Kerr is an illustrator and comic book artist. He graduated from the Illustration department at Glasgow School of Art in 2004 and the Communication Art and Design department at the Royal College of Art in 2006, David works with graphite, charcoal, Indian ink, gouache and using a Wacom tablet to create illustrations for commissioned assignments and self-motivated projects.

Presented within the touching stories exhibition are a series of drawings taken from a graphic novel titled Adam's Dream. The story follows the lives of a nine year old girl, her twelve year old brother and one of his school mates and visualises a world in which pornographic branding, imagery and language have become quotidian.

In Adams dream lads magazines and woman's weeklies such as Loaded, FHM, Nuts, Zoo, Closer, Heat, Grazia and Star are un-regulated and frequently sold to minors. The products in the children's bedrooms, purchased from high street retailers, are adorned by pornography distributors brands and logos and via their personal computers, hand held games consoles and mobile phones a more extreme world beckons the children's interest. Playing out from this scenario Adams Dream imagines how this environment will influence the three characters behavior during the day and the dreams they have at night.
